COVID-19 Vaccinations Underway

At the end of January, Cook County entered into Phase 1B of its COVID-19 vaccine rollout, which makes the vaccine available to frontline essential workers and to all Illinois residents age 65 and older. Some of those classified as eligible essential workers are first responders, teachers, grocery store workers, postal workers, public transit workers, and those that work in the food service, agriculture, and manufacturing industries.

Illinois further expanded Phase 1B eligibility on February 25th to include those age 16-64 with high-risk medical conditions, such as cancer, diabetes, or pregnancy. However, at the time of this article, Cook County has opted not to join the rest of the state in this expansion of eligibility, citing limited vaccine supply.



The administration of the vaccine to residents throughout Riverside Township is under the jurisdiction of the State of Illinois and the Cook County Department of Public Health. Demand is high and as the vaccine continues to remain in limited supply, it will be administered **by appointment only**.

To sign-up for a COVID-19 vaccination appointment through Cook County, you can visit: <https://vaccine.cookcountyil.gov/>. You can also try calling their Vaccine Sign-up Hotline at **(833) 308-1988**, Monday – Friday, from 7:00 am – 7:00 pm.

The nearest state-supported vaccination site is the Cook County Health Center in North Riverside, located at 1800 S. Harlem Avenue, and is **by appointment only**, Monday – Saturday, from 9:00 am – 5:00 pm. Several local health systems also offer vaccines to their patients, including myLoyola and Oak Street Health. Walgreens, Jewel-Osco, and Walmart locations are taking vaccination appointments for those eligible under Phase 1B as well. You can make an online appointment with them through these links:

Important Property Tax Info

The Riverside Township Assessor's Office is committed to helping taxpayers stay informed and proactive about keeping their property taxes as low as possible. The largest savings in property taxes comes from Homeowner, Senior Citizen, and Senior Citizen Freeze exemptions. Additional savings can be had for veterans and for individuals with disabilities. Property taxes are based on assessed values determined every 3 years by the Cook County Assessor and all exemptions appear on 2nd installment property tax bills. Taxpayers who believe the assessed value of their home is not fair should file an appeal either with the Cook County Assessor or later in the year with the Cook County Board of Review.

In an effort to make exemption applications as easy as possible, the Cook County Assessor's Office has provided taxpayers with the ability to **apply for all exemptions online** using the Docu-Sign process. Taxpayers who think they may qualify for an exemption, or would like help in filing for one, should contact the Riverside Township Assessor's Office for in-person or over the phone guidance. Due to the implementation of the new online application process, **paper applications are no longer available**.

2020 first installment property taxes were due by Tuesday, March 2, 2021. Due to the pandemic, the Cook County Treasurer is waiving late penalties through May 3, 2021. Taxpayers who did not receive their first installment tax bill may find them online at the Cook County Treasurer's website: www.cookcountytreasurer.com. Payments may also be made via their website.



The appeal period for Riverside Township will begin sometime in March. Taxpayers wishing to appeal the assessed value of their property will have a 30-day window to file an appeal, which can easily be processed online. The Township Assessor, Fran Sitkiewicz, is available to provide assistance and comparables for residential properties within the Township.

The Riverside Township Assessor's Office remains open and fully staffed to continue to serve taxpayers, with health and safety measures in place. The office is open for walk-ins; however, it would be preferable to schedule an appointment first by calling **(708) 447-7700** or sending an email to: assessor@riversidetownship.org.

Resource Center Provides Guidance

The Riverside Township Community Resource Center remains open and available by phone or email to provide guidance and referrals for aging services, benefits counseling (by appointment), intellectual and developmental disability services, mental health services, substance abuse services, and more. Paper Shredding Event Planned In March



To celebrate the first day of Spring, Riverside Township will be hosting another "Shred-A-Thon" event on **Saturday, March 20th, from 9:00 am - Noon**. The always popular event will once again be held in the **Riverside Masonic Lodge parking lot at 40 Forest Avenue in Riverside**. What better way to jumpstart your spring cleaning efforts than by purging old documents cluttering up your storage space?

This **FREE** event is only for Riverside Township residents and only for personal, confidential documents. No business shredding. Each household will be restricted to **no more than 3 boxes of paper**, and all documents will be securely destroyed on site by American Mobile Shredding and Recycling.

Please note: be sure to remove all paper clips, binder clips, and spiral binders before you bring your items. Do not bring magazines, newspapers, junk mail, or other items that belong in traditional recycling. This shredding event is only for confidential papers with personal information that you wish to have destroyed and disposed of securely.

For your health and safety during the Covid-19 Pandemic, this will be a contactless, drive-up event. Place your documents in the trunk of your car, follow the signs and then simply pop the trunk. No need to get out of your car; we will remove the documents from your vehicle and shred them.
